Hiking

Red Pine Gondola-Take a quick ride up the Red Pine Gondola which is just across the plaza from us. From the top of the Red Pine Gondola, start working your way up to the top of 9990 and the top of the resort! From the top you can see into Big Cottonwood Canyon. If you are feeling ambitious, you can hike all the way over to Park City and take the Town Lift to Main Street. Better hurry though! The lifts close at 4pm.

Uinta National Forest- if you are up for a drive, hop in your car and head for **Mirror Lake Highway**. This is a beautiful stretch of two-lane road with great opportunities to take off into the mountains.

Mountain Dell is a short convenient drive from both Salt Lake City and Park City. Exit 134 on I-80, between Park City and Salt Lake City, is the home of Mountain Dell Golf Course. Mountain Dell is a premier Utah Golf Course, nestled in the natural landscape of Parley's Canyon. The Canyon Course stretches up the eastern mountain from the clubhouse approximately four miles before looping back. The Lake Course features narrow, rolling fairways and dramatic tee shots over deep ravines and water.
